

# Public Hearing Invitation



**NIPRO PharmaPackaging Americas Inc.**, 1200 N. 10th Street, Millville, NJ 08332 (NPA) invites members of the community to attend a **public hearing** regarding the renewal of its **Title V Operating Permit** (BOP23001) & **Modification** (BOP250001).

NPA has submitted a timely renewal application for its Title V Operating **Permit** (BOP23001). The company has operated at its Millville location since 2011, which includes a **Tube Draw facility** with seven production lines manufacturing glass tubing for pharmaceutical packaging applications. Additionally, NPA operates a **converting plant** with sixteen forming machines producing a range of vials, ampoules, and syringes for the pharmaceutical market.

As part of the renewal application, NPA has requested certain Title V Operating **Modifications** (BOP250001) intended to improve operational flexibility. These modifications **will not have a negative impact on the local community**. Upon final approval by NJDEP, the permit will be renewed for an additional five years.

## Public Hearing Details

This hearing is being held in accordance with the Environmental Justice rules (N.J.A.C. 7:1C). The hearing will be conducted **in person**, with an additional option for the public to



participate **virtually**. The virtual session will be recorded and made available online for public viewing until the close of the public comment period.

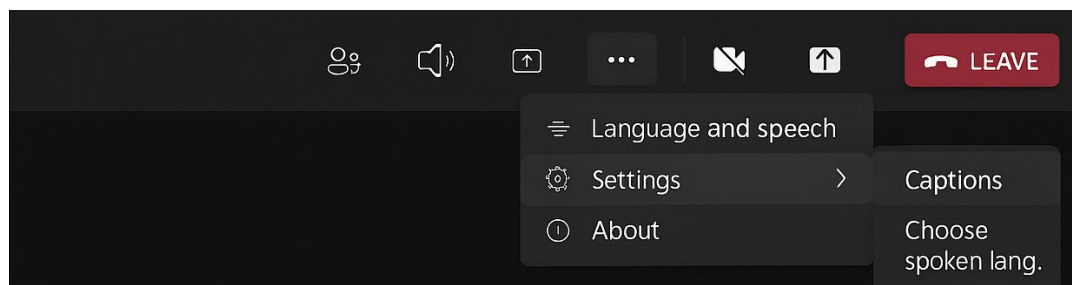
